Esquire Innovations Releases iRedline 7 Enhancement Pack 3

Temecula, CA. January xx, 2011 – Esquire Innovations, Inc., a leading provider of Microsoft Office integration software for law firms, has released a new Enhancement Pack (EP) of iRedline 7, the company's document comparison software. iRedline 7 EP3, supports Microsoft Word 2007 and 2010.

The new EP adds the ability to compare portions of text from a single document or multiple documents, further address author and date information in tracked changes and easily combine all pages with revisions to a single PDF file. The EP also enhances the OpenText document management system integration.

Dependent upon the firm's standards, the resulting iRedline document can be saved as a new document, sent as an e-mail attachment or embedded as an object in the revised document. The comparison settings, which control the elements to be compared, and format of the result document can be specified through the iRedline scheme. iRedline 7 EP3 also provides the ability to compare documents stored on local or network drives, or that are accessed from document management systems, such as Interwoven, OpenText and Worldox, and to add reports and change lists to the result document.

Esquire's products, including iRedline, utilize Enhanced Native Architecture™ (ENA). ENA is the methodology for retaining the look and feel of Microsoft Word to promote streamlined workflow and reduce end user training requirements. In addition, by retaining Word's native capabilities, an electronic document can be used for collaboration purposes more effectively. With its improved comparison engine and expanded technological capabilities Word 2007/2010 has now matured into a core product that iRedline 7 can fully leverage.
